Faces

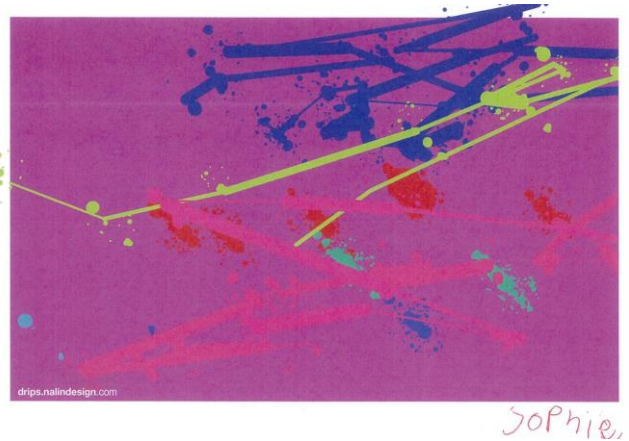
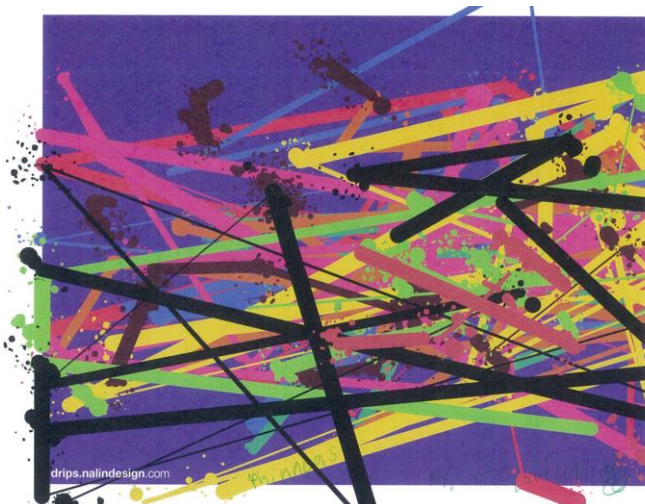
