Summer Breakfast Tips



Ingredients

- 1 mango, peeled and chopped
- 2 kiwi fruit, peeled and chopped
- 2 tbs freshly squeezed orange juice
- 2 x 170g tubs reduced-fat mango yoghurt
- 1 cup granola-style breakfast cereal

Method

 3. Eat straightaway or place in the fridge for up to an hour
