### BUNNINGS BBQ



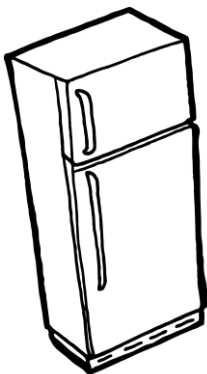
