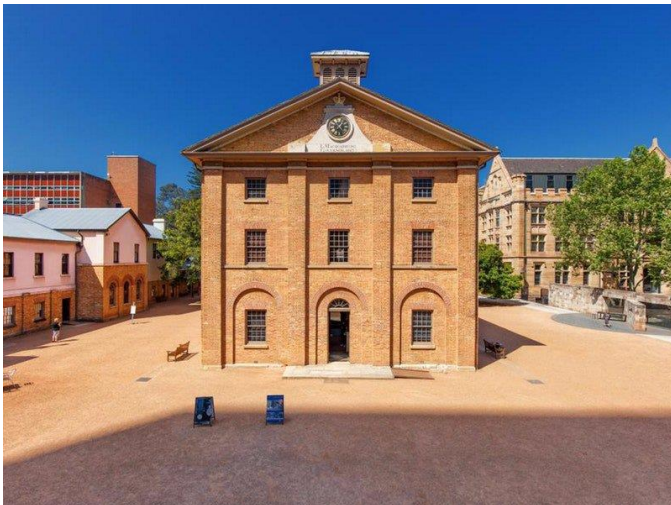
Education Week
