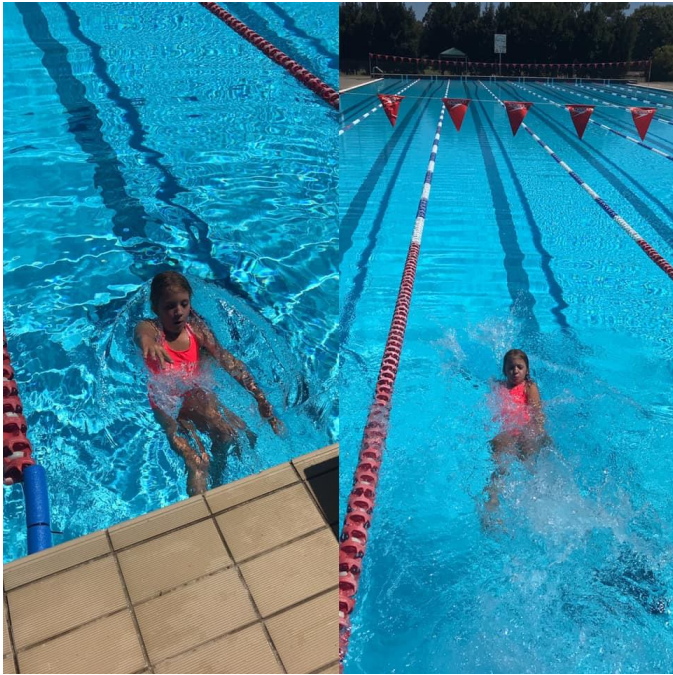
PSSA District Swimming Carnival

Also qualifying for zone, was Matilda Ashcroft in the 50m girls freestyle and 50m girls breaststroke.

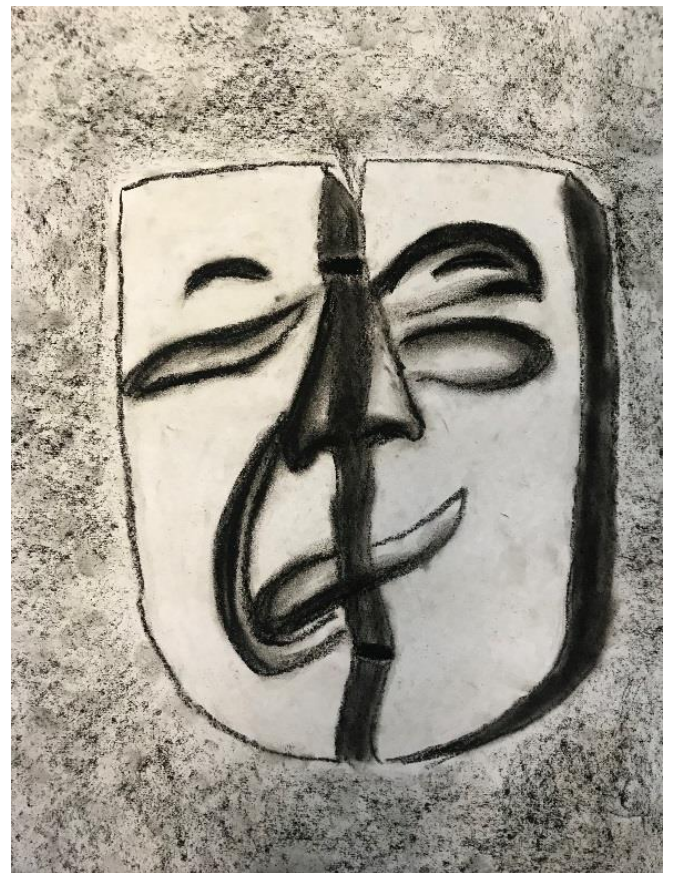
The overall point scoring school, on the day, went to Hannam Vale who were very deserving.
