Students and parents have long complained that our school uniform shirt is too hot and easily stained when wearing for sport. Well the P&C have been working on a solution in conjunction with staff and students.

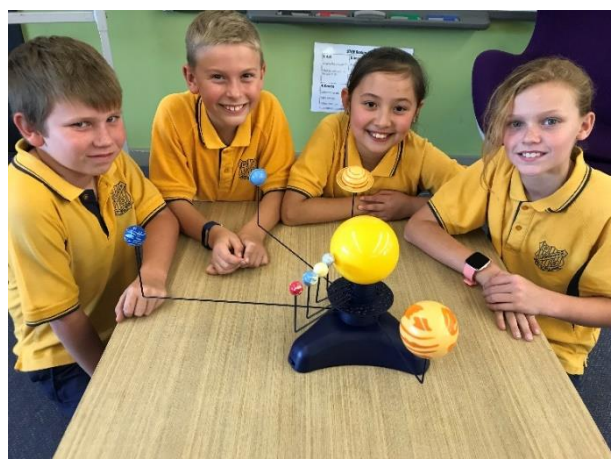
There is a sample of the shirt on display in the office for everyone to come along and check out. Consulting with families is a priority for us as we value everyones opinion.
