Head Lice

We currently have a case of Head Lice here at school. Your child might be carrying them. Would all parents/carers please check your child's hair just to be on the safe side. If head lice are found, there are some handy tips below.

Tips for tackling kids head lice

- Use over the counter head lice treatment (there are many on the market) or simply a standard hair conditioner and a fine head lice comb.
- Apply treatment/conditioner to the hair and comb through with a wide-toothed comb to remove the tangles.
- Then use a fine metal lice comb to remove the lice and pull the nits off the hair.
- Wash out treatment/conditioner as per instructions






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P&C News
